TYPHOON ANNOUNCES THE PUBLICATION OF THE 43-101 REPORT ON THE FAYOLLE SHOWING

Laval, Canada, March 02, 2007 – Typhoon Exploration inc. (TSX Venture Exchange symbol: TOO) announces that the National Instrument 43-101 compliant resource estimate report for the Fayolle gold showing mineralization is now available on the Sedar web site at www.sedar.com and www.explorationtyphon.com.

The resource estimate dated January 19, 2007 completed by **Innovexplor Inc.**, of Val-d'Or, Quebec, **consists of 148,609 ounces of gold in Inferred Resources (6,568,600 tonnes at 0.7 g/t Au) and an additional 39,397 ounces of gold in Indicated Resources (848,600 tonnes at 1.4 g/t Au).**

These resources are located at shallow depth and are potentially accessible from surface.

The total of 16 drill holes has been completed since December 2006 on the Aiguebelle Goldfields gold occurrence. As soon as drill results are available, they will be published by press release. As of today, some 20 drill holes have been completed on the Aiguebelle Goldfields.

A significant drill campaign is in progress on the Fayolle property.
