

TYPHOON ACQUIRES KEY GROUND NEAR GOLDCORP IN JAMES BAY MINING CAMP, QUEBEC

Laval, Canada, June 19th 2007 – TYPHOON EXPLORATION INC. (the «Company»; TSX-V: **TOO**) announces that the Company has **acquired a 58 claim property totalling 30.3 km²** («Opinaca property»), located about **2 km from Goldcorp's claim group, including the Eleonore Gold Project, in the Opinaca sector of the new James Bay Mining Camp** (Quebec).

The Opinaca property is located west of the Eleonore Project, where *Goldcorp* acquired the project in 2006 for C\$ 500 million. Eleonore hosts significant gold mineralization with drill assay results grading up to 18.85 g/t gold over 16 m and 12.37 g/t gold over 23 m (*Virginia Mines Inc. at www.virginia.qc.ca*).



The Opinaca property hosts sedimentary units and intrusives, all highly prospective for gold mineralization. **The property is transacted by the north-south running Matagami to Radisson Highway, that would facilitate access for the upcoming exploration work.**

The Company will earn a 100% interest in the property by paying C\$ 20,000 to the vendor and issuing 500,000 shares.

Following the significant results obtained by numerous companies working in this new and promising mining camp, the Company will undertake exploration work to define a number of targets likely leading to the discovery of gold.

About Typhoon Exploration Inc.

The Company has no debt and has more than C\$ 5 million in funds. In 2007, the Company plans to invest C\$ 4 million in exploration.

Mineral resource estimates for the Fayolle Showing are 148,600 ounces of gold in Inferred Resources to which 39,400 ounces of gold are added in the Indicated Resources (news release of January 19, 2007). These resources are near surface and are within surface reach. A drilling program is underway at Fayolle.

An exploration campaign is in progress in Chibougamau on the Monexco project. (Gold)

An exploration campaign will begin in the near term on the Côte-Nord project. (Uranium)
